Holy Cross Primary School strives to provide quality education for all learners within a Catholic, Christian ethos. Holy Cross Primary School is not a convent. However, it is a Catholic school and in order to maintain it's Catholic identity, which has stood it in good stead for over 105 years, there are three aspects of Catholicism which staff and children are expected to participate in:

1. School Mass : Four school Masses (one per term) where we ask the Lord to bless our school for the term. The final Grade 7 Mass at the end of each year where we ask a blessing on our Grade 7 pupils as they start their High School careers.
2. Morning Prayer: Morning prayers are opened and closed with acknowledgement of the Holy Trinity in the form of making the Sign of The Cross.
3. Assembly: All learners and staff recite three short Catholic prayers once a week at assembly.  
In terms of the Catholic character of the school, a crucifix will be found in each room and a variety of statues and religious pictures are displayed in various areas of the school. In respect and acknowledgement of other Christian faiths, an inter-denominational religious programme for those children not attending Catholic Catechism takes place four mornings a week. In addition to this, an inter-denominational thanks-giving service takes place at the end of each term. All staff and learners are expected to attend these services.
