HOLY CROSS SCHOOL RULES



SCHOOL GROUNDS

• 1st Bell: Move to lines

• 2nd Bell: Silence

- Children must walk and not run on paved areas
- Keep our playground litter-free
- No playing with sticks and stones or any dangerous objects
- No climbing in trees
- Ball games are only allowed on the Astro, in the Garden and on Dumpy courts
- No ball games before and after school hours
- Bullying, teasing, taunting, ridiculing, swearing or fighting will not be tolerated
- Only Grade 1 to 3 learners may play on the jungle gyms during allocated times
- No playing on the apparatus before and after school hours

STAFF CARPARK

Out of bounds to all pupils and parents

GATES

- Pupils must stand inside the school gates while waiting for lifts.
- Waiting on the pavement is not allowed
- Pupils and parents must use the pedestrian gate when entering or leaving the school
- Pupils must be vigilant of the vehicles driving in and out of the driveway

PASSAGE

- Out of bounds before school and at break times, except on rainy days.
- Pupils who have break time detention in the passage may leave 5 minutes before the end-of- break bell
- Pupils must keep left and walk quietly in a single file at all times

STAFFROOM

 No pupils may enter the staffroom at any time and should consult the teacher on duty if in need of assistance

SWIMMING

- Children may not wander around the school in their swimming costumes
- No pupil may enter the pool area without a teacher
- Clothing must be worn over swimming costumes unless in the pool area
- Pupils must be fully dressed before leaving the school grounds

CELLPHONES AND ELECTRONIC DEVICES

 Cellphones and electronic devices are not allowed at school. If children are found with them, it will be confiscated and handed back at the end of the term

BATHROOMS

- Keep toilets and basins clean flush toilets after use
- Respect privacy of others (only one person per cubicle)
- No standing on toilet seats
- No playing or eating in bathrooms
- Report any damage immediately

ASTRO

- Only the designated class may go on the Astro during allocated times at break
- Pupils must wait at the gate for the teacher on duty
- No hanging on nets or deliberate damage of the surface
- No food/sweets are allowed on the Astro

SCHOOL HALL / ASSEMBLY

- Hall out of bounds without permission from a teacher or member of staff
- For Assembly:
 - line up quickly and quietly outside hall
 - lead in quietly on instruction from teacher
 - respond appropriately e.g. clapping
 - stand when singing the school and national anthems
 - obey educators and student councillors

CORRIDORS AND STAIRWAYS

- Move quietly and in single file
- Keep to the left
- No running or eating
- Line up quietly outside classroom
- Stack cases / sport bags and equipment neatly in designated area / outside classrooms
- No loitering in the school buildings before school, during breaks or after school hours

DRESS CODE

- Pupils must always wear the correct Holy Cross Primary School uniform (clearly marked) and dress neatly in accordance with the dress code of the school
- Pupils must have the correct sport equipment and clothing (clearly marked) applicable to various school / sport activities

JEWELLERY

- No jewellery may be worn except a cross on a chain. This should not be visible, but worn underneath the shirt
- Only watches with silver, gold, black or blue straps may be worn. No ornamental watches will be allowed
- Only studs or sleepers are allowed for the girls with pierced ears

CIVVIES DAYS

- Pupils are to dress appropriately
- The girls' hair must be tied up as for a normal school day
- No make-up or fancy jewellery may be worn
- No spaghetti strap tops, low hipster jeans, 'short' shorts or bare midriffs are allowed

HAIR POLICY

Girls:

- To be worn off the face loose hair must be clipped back or an Alice band band must be worn
- Fringes are not allowed to hang in eyes
- Hair must be tied up when it reaches shoulder length
- Gel is not allowed
- Hair accessories navy scrunchies, ribbons, hair bands, blue or black Alice bands and clips
- 'Fashion' hair styles and any cut/style that draws attention are not permitted
- Braiding, to ensure a neat appearance, is allowed
- No tinting, dyeing or bleaching of hair

Boys:

- Short and neat
- Hair must be worn off the collar
- Hair is not permitted to hang over the ears
- Fringes are not permitted to hang in the eyes
- Gel is not allowed
- 'Fashion' hair styles such as 'step' cuts and any cut / style that draws attention are not permitted

GENERAL

- Meet and Greet
- Stand back for adults in doorways
- Stand, if sitting, when approached by an adult
- Offer to help adults e.g. find the office or carry books
- After school hours, pupils need to be in full school uniform or full school sports clothes in public areas
